Directions to Show

From Fort Worth: go north on Interstate 35W to US Hwy 287W (towards Decatur/Bridgeport). Follow 287 approx. 12 miles and exit at Texas Hwy 114W (Rhome/Boyd/Bridgeport). Go west approx. 10 miles; exit right and go left/south under overpass. Follow FM51 about 1 mile and turn right/west on FM2123 (towards Cottdale). Go 3 miles and turn left/south on CR3585 (corner gas station on right). When road Ts (1 mile) turn right. At the left curve, turn right into driveway. North Texas Whip sign at entrance.
