Golf carts available for rental must call or email to reserve and for pricing. ATV type vehicles allowed however, organizing committee reserves right to request anyone driving inappropriately to leave the competition. Licensed drivers only permitted. All dowgs must be leashed. MCDE committee and vet recommend all equines be shod and conditioned for the marathon.

From I-69 : take Lapeer exit 155 (M24) south to Dryden Rd. Go east on Dryden Rd for 3.6 miles to Barber Rd. Turn south onto Barber Rd for 1/2 mile to Windrush Farm. Stabling drive is down hill south of farm.
