Continue on Route 213 North to Route 273. Turn right onto Route 273 and continue to Entrance 3 on right and follow directions to Stabling. From South: I-95 North to Exit 100, Route 272 North. Follow Route 272 North for five miles to Route 273. Turn right onto Route 273 East and continue for six miles. Go through the intersection of Route 273 and Route 213 passing the Fair Hill Inn. Continue to Entrance 3 on right and follow directions to Stabling.
