Entry/Class Fees: \$250 for Preliminary and Intermediate, \$300 FEI; Entry/Class Fees: \$310 USEF, \$260 ADS; **Post Entry Fees:** \$100 Additional for any entries postmarked after closing date. Also, ANY change in entry voids original entry and the new entry will be treated as a Post Entry and it will incur the additional \$100 fee. **Entry Fee Refund Policy:** Full refund less \$100 before closing. After closing date, refund minus \$100 with a Doctor or Vet Certificate. **Stall Fee:** \$150 from the date stables open. Additional nights shall be charged at \$25/night and arrangements for early arrival or late departure must be made in writing (email preferred) with show secretary or they will not be honored; **Stall Deposit:** \$30; **Separate Check?** Yes; **Stall Refund Policy:** Refund of stall fee minus \$25 prior to closing date, refund minus \$25 after closing date with a Doctor or Vet Certificate. **Other Fees:** Grounds Fee \$50 for any horses/ponies not stabled on grounds. Test(s): Training Test #2, Preliminary Test #2, Preliminary Test #5 for Tandems or Teams, Intermediate Test 7, FEI 9 for Horse and Pony Singles, FEI 8B for Horse and Pony Pairs, FEI 8A for Horse Teams and FEI 8C for Pony Teams.

Ring/Warm-up area Footing: Grass / Grass

Other Dressage Info: Intermediate, Advanced and Prelim Teams or Tandems in 40 X 100 m arena, All other Prelim and Training in 40 X 80 m arena.

MARATHON

Terrain: Grass and dirt roads, some sand.

Level: Training; 3 Sections; Up to 12 km; Up to 5 Obstacles

Level: Preliminary; 3 Sections; Up to 14 km; Up to 6 Obstacles

Level: Intermediate; 3 Sections; Up to 15 km; Up to 7 Obstacles

Level: Advanced; Sections per USEF rules; Up to 18 km; Up to 8 Obstacles

CONES

Ring/Warm-up area Footing: All Weather Composite Surface/All Weather Composite Surface

Level: Training, Preliminary, Intermediate; Standard Cones/Obstacle Settings shall be used per ADS Rules

Level: Advanced; Standard Settings per USEF Rules

OTHER INFORMATION

Veterinary/Health Requirements: Negative Coggins within 1 year of show date. A Health Certificate within 30 days is required for entry into the state of Florida.

Stabling Information: The Florida Horse Park requests that shavings be purchased from the Park. Shavings are \$9 per bag and may be ordered in advance (email preferred). Stalls are temporary with canvas over steel frame doors.

Driver/Groom twice around allowed on marathon? (Article 917) Drivers and Navigators, or any combination thereof, may go a MAXIMUM of 2 times on course, schedule permitting.

Misc. Show Info: No Dogs allowed in any of the competition areas or show office. Dogs must be on a leash at ALL times. Any loose dogs will go to Doggie Jail. Bail is set at \$100 for each offense. :-)
Organizer reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes within a division, or to refuse any entry. Please be sure your entry contains a copy of your ADS membership card, your USEF membership card, if Advanced Division, and Pony Measurement Card. Passports are not required for Advanced Division, however, a means of identification is required to be presented at the Vet Inspection. If you do not have a passport, a Coggins Test is acceptable, as long as it contains a picture or a description of the horse/s. Please check the FHP website for entry status, stabling charts, and order(s) of go, etc.

Awards Offered: Class awards 1-6 place. Other special awards. Competitors will be eligible for the Florida Triple Crown Awards to be presented at the Kingdom of the Sun for Preliminary and Training and Live Oak International for Intermediate and Advanced/FEI competitors.

Camping On Grounds: Yes. There are a limited number of 30amp hookups available for \$200 and \$50 per night for early arrival and late departure. The fee for camping without a hookup is \$100.

Camping Off Grounds: Yes, Ocala Sun RV Resort, 352-307-1100 (approx. 4 miles away)

Directions to Show: From I-75, take the Bellevue/Dunnellon exit (CR 484) which is 1 exit south of Ocala. Turn east and go to the second light which is CR 475. Turn north and go 2.7 miles to the Horse Park entrance on the left of the road. **USE CAUTION AT THE RAILROAD CROSSING.**
