Obstacle Class Notes: Competitors can drive each obstacle class only once, no cross-entering allowed.

Ring/Warm-up area Footing: Grass/Grass

Awards Offered: Places 1 – 6 in individual classes. Champion and Reserve ribbons for each division. Must enter classes 1,2,3,4,7,8,11, to qualify for FHP Show Championship. Must have entered Purely Pleasure 2012, Grand Oaks 2013 and this show to qualify for the Florida Pleasure Triple Crown Championship.

Misc. Class Info: Junior: age 18 or younger. Utility turnout: Marathon carriage, Wire Wheels, or Pneumatic Tires. Traditional turnout: normal pleasure or antique carriage. Multiples enter classes based on size of largest equine in turnout. If combined with other classes, multiples, juniors, novices are scored separately for championship. USEF MEMBERS – Points to count toward HOTY Awards, as applicable. Horses and Drivers must be registered with the USEF for the points to count towards HOTY Awards.
