## DRESSAGE

**Test(s):** *All Classes:* Training: # Test 2; Preliminary: #Test 2

**Ring/Warm-up area Footing:** Grass / Grass

**Other Dressage Info:** Arena Size: pony and horse: 40x80; VSE Training: 20x40, VSE Preliminary 30x60 NO exceptions, you must compete in the same size arena as others in the same class.

## MARATHON

**Terrain:** Rolling hills, some with steep inclines, tree lined trails, some gravel roads, pastures, creek crossing that may or may not have water.

**Level:** Training; 1 Section; up to 5 km; 5 Obstacles

**Level:** Preliminary; 1 Section; up to 8 km; 5 Obstacles

**Other:** Training: VSE, Pony, and Horse will all follow same Training route. Preliminary: Pony and Horse follow the complete Preliminary route. VSE route will be shorter as it will not include the steep uphill portion known as "The Mesa." VSE may have special obstacle(s).

## CONES

**Ring/Warm-up area Footing:** Grass / Grass

**Level:** VSE Training; Clearance: 35 cm

**Level:** Training; Clearance: 40 cm

**Level:** VSE Preliminary; Clearance: 30 cm

**Level:** Preliminary; Clearance: 35 cm

**Other:** VSE, Pony & Horse all follow same cones course with same number of obstacles.

## OTHER INFORMATION

**Veterinary/Health Requirements:** Negative Coggins in-state within 1 year, since April 6, 2013; out-of-state within 6 months, since October 6, 2013. Must send Coggins with entry!. Paperwork will be checked before horses can be unloaded. No exceptions.

**Stabling Information:** 10x10 stalls in barn. No overnight trailer tying; however, stock panels and temporary corrals are allowed. Please contact Organizer with questions.

**Driver/Groom twice around allowed on marathon? (Article 917)** Yes as schedule and time allow.

**Misc. Show info:** Management reserves the right to refuse any entry. Dogs must be kept on leashes and controlled; no motorized vehicles except golf carts allowed on marathon course, section E obstacles are within walking distance. Assistance provided if needed.

**Awards Offered:** Elegant ribbons for places 1 to 6 in all classes, awards for Best Dressage in each division and Best Conditioned Horse. If warranted, Young Driver Award and Navigator Recognition Award.

**Food Available on the Grounds:** Yes, caterer on site Fri. 6:00 p.m.- Sun. approximately 10 a.m.

**Directions to Show:** From Fort Worth: go north on Interstate 35W to US Hwy 287W (towards Decatur/Bridgeport). Follow 287 approx. 12 miles and exit at Texas Hwy 114W (Rhome/Boyd/Bridgeport). Go west approx. 10 miles; go left/ south on FM51 about 1 mile and turn right/west on FM2123 (towards Cottondale). Go 3 miles and turn left/south on CR3585 (corner store on right). When road T's (1 mile) turn right. At the next left curve, turn right into driveway. North Texas Whip sign at entrance.
