### CONES

**Ring/Warm-up area Footing:** Arena composite mix / warm-up also on grass

**All Levels:** Speed and clearance as per ADS Rules

### OTHER INFORMATION

**Veterinary/Health Requirements:** Negative Coggins and Rabies within 1 year of show date. GEA Complies with USET Foundation Bio-Security Policy please see www.gladstone driving.org for details and required form. 48 hour vet certificate required and USET Foundation BioSecurity Form. The show will provide a vet on Thurs May 1 from noon til 5pm to check in horses for temp and general condition. Horses may not unload from trailers until they are checked in.

**Stabling Information:** Temporary tent stalls with doors. Minimal Electric **Driver/Groom twice around allowed on marathon? (Article 917) YES if schedule permits. Second entry will compete HC. Include written request with entry. Driver going twice:** Entries MUST be in separate divisions. Entries for drivers going twice in same division will not be accepted. Navigators may accompany more than one entry. However due to scheduling conflicts, navigators may go a maximum of 2 times, and must be in separate divisions. Please include written request with entry.

**Misc. Show Info:** All information regarding acceptance of entry, anything that is missing from your entry, and time schedules will be posted on www.gladstonedriving.org as soon as it becomes available after the closing date. All dogs must be on leash at ALL times. No two-wheeled motor vehicles permitted.
