Coming from the North; Take I-75 South to Exit #126 (RT 62 Georgetown/Cynthiana) Turn to the left off the exit ramp and go to the fourth stop light. Toyota is on your left. Turn right and the Gayla Driving Center will be 3.7 miles on the right. Same as above.
