**Combined Test:** Training, Preliminary, and Intermediate, VSE, Pony & Horse, Singles and Pairs. Preliminary and Intermediate for Juniors to drive, single.

**Pleasure Show Division:** VSE, Novice, Junior, Single Horse, Single Pony, Pair Horse, Pair Pony, Multiple Horse/Pony (Four-In-Hand, Unicorn or Tandem), American Heritage, Trade/Commercial, \*Utility, and \*\*Draft.

**\*Utility Division:** is open to single ponies and single horses put to a two or four-wheeled training/marathon type vehicle not suitable for the other divisions. Pneumatic tires acceptable in Utility Division. Orleton Farm house rules. No cross entries.

**\*\*Draft Division:** To be shown according to Orleton Farm house rules (see prize list) and judged according to ADS Pleasure Show guidelines. Open to any non-farm vehicle, single or pair.

**Post Closing Date Fee:** \$30 per class **Entry Fee Refund Policy:** Refunds will be made only upon receipt of a veterinarian's or physician's certificate attesting to the inability of the animal or driver to participate due to injury or illness. The certificate must be received prior to the opening of the show on June 13. **Stall Fee:** \$135.
