Test(s): Training: Test # 2, Limited and Open Preliminary: Test #1

Ring/Warm-up area Footing: Grass/dirt

Other Dressage Info: Presentation on the move, with safety check 30 minutes prior. All tests in a 40x80m arena

MARATHON

Terrain: rolling dirt roads through woods and fields

Level: Training; 3 Sections; 9-11 km; 5 Obstacles

Level: Preliminary; 3 Sections; 10-12 km; 6 Obstacles

Other: safety check 20 minutes prior to start time. Costumes encouraged on marathon day. Protective headgear required per Article 917.6.4 (no shorts allowed)

CONES

Ring/Warm-up area Footing: dry grass and dirt field

Level: Training; Clearance: Per ADS article 952.1.6

Level: Preliminary; Clearance: Per ADS article 952.1.6

Other: Cones immediately follows Dressage test on Sat.

Veterinary/Health Requirements: Negative Coggins within 1 year of show date

Stabling Information: Temporary stalls, pipe corral or self stabling

Driver/Groom twice around allowed on marathon? (Article 917) Yes.
